Advanced Level Curriculum Overview
Grades 3-4

The advanced level will continue their progress through the curriculum ascertained by the Indonesian government supported by Berbahasa Indonesia Book Kurikulum 2004 published by Balai Pustaka.

The four language skills (namely: speaking, writing, listening and reading) will be developed at the same time. The teaching and learning activities will focus on language practice rather than be book oriented. The living values will also be inserted in the teaching and learning process. It is aimed to help make learning Bahasa Indonesia fun and beneficial.

Some topics will be discussed throughout the meeting in this term :

- **Event**

The Major public holidays: Indonesia National Day, Idul Fitri, Good Friday, Galungan and Nyepi

- **Hobbies**

All children will confidently tell about their hobbies so they become proud and confident story tellers

- **Environment**

Children will share ideas about what a good and healthy environment is

- **Public places**

In relation with public places, the students are required to tell others how to take care of public places, what to do and what not to do in public places, how to treat others in public places and how to use public places effectively and efficiently.

These themes will include listening to and retelling stories, reading short stories and writing with correct punctuation.

BAHASA INDONESIA
LEVEL ADVANCE: KURIKULUM OVERVIEW

Level advance akan melanjutkan kemampuan mereka dalam menggunakan bahasa Indonesia berlandaskan atas kurikulum yang dicetuskan oleh pemerintah Indonesia dan didukung oleh buku berbahasa Indonesia yang diterbitkan oleh Balai Pustaka.

Keempat aspek berbahasa (berbicara, menulis, mendengarkan dan membaca) akan dikembangkan bersama sama. Kegiatan belajar mengajar akan difokuskan kepada praktek berbahasa dibandingkan dengan berorientasi pada penggunaan buku semata. Beberapa topik yang akan dibicarakan pada semester ini :

Semua siswa akan dengan bangga menceritakan tentang kegemaran nya sehingga mereka akan menjadi orang yang bangga terhadap diri nya sendiri.

- **Lingkungan**

Anak anak akan saling berbagi mengenai aa yang dimaksud dengan lingkungan yang bersih dan sehat

- **Tempat umum**

Sehubungan dengan tempat tempat umum, anak anak diarsikan untuk menceritakan kepada teman nya bagaimana cara menjaga tempat umum apa yang boleh dan tidak boleh dilakukan di tempat umum, bagaimana cara memperlakukan orang di tempat umum dan menggunakan tempat umum dengan efektif dan efisien.

Semua tema tema diatas akan mencakup mendengarkan dan menceritakan kembali suatu cerita, membaca cerita pendek, menulis dengan ejaan yang benar.
